Did you know that: a) there are 27 million slaves in the world today, 3 times more than when William Wilberforce fought the trans-Atlantic slave trade?

- b) 70% of these people are trafficked for purposes of sexual exploitation
- c) 80% are women and children
- d) Large sporting events like the Olympics are accompanied by a rise in demand for paid sex and the trafficking of women and girls
- e) You can join the growing tide of Baptists and other Christians who are speaking out against this huge crime against humanity.

Launched in Vancouver, Buying Sex Is Not a Sport is a grassroots campaign to stem human trafficking and the demand for prostitutes at the 2010 Winter Olympics. It has been spearheaded by a Baptist woman, Michelle Miller who is speaking on **Sat Jan 30** at Walmer Road Baptist Church and **Mon, Feb 1**, (both at 8 pm) in the U. of Toronto Health Sciences Building, 155 College St, Rm. 610.
