Rev. Dr. Sam Chaise (CBM)

Sam Chaise started as General Secretary of CBM on October 1, 2010. He has been involved in Canadian Baptist life for many years. He served as Associate Pastor at Kitsilano Christian Community Church in Vancouver and then as

Pastor of Worship & Outreach at Emmanuel Baptist Church in Saskatoon. From 2002-2007 he was the Lead Pastor at Olivet Baptist Church in New Westminster, BC. Just prior to his appointment at CBM, Sam served as Director of the newly formed Carey Institute at Carey Theological College in Vancouver, which was launched to provide accessible and relevant training and education to the churches of Canadian Baptists of Western Canada.

Aside from these roles, Sam has also been deeply involved with Canadian Baptists in volunteer capacities. This includes stints as the Board President of the Baptist Union of Western Canada and as a CBM Board member from 2007-2009. Sam was born in England and grew up in Sudbury, Ontario.
