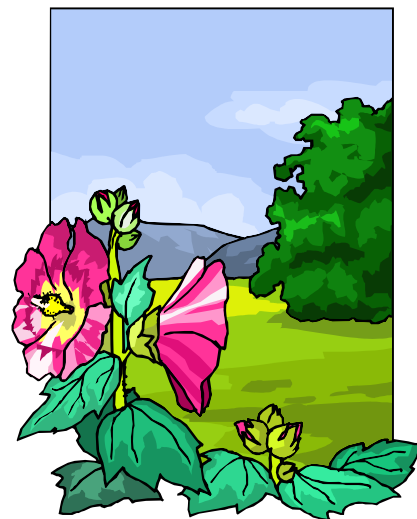
• MISSION RETREAT: "BIBLE, MISSION & ME" Sat. Feb. 5 (1 pm to 3 pm) @ NTCBC
