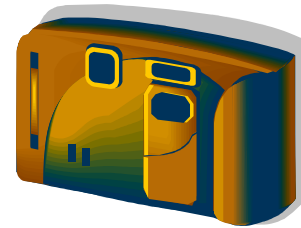

In Mark 10:18, why did Jesus say "Why do you call me good"? This seems to imply that Jesus was not "good".

Response:

The man was asking Jesus for a way to earn eternal life by human achievement. Jesus' answer forces him to realize that only God is inherently good and therefore the only person who can give eternal life; so the man should depend upon God alone. By questioning the man's use of the term "good", Jesus' intention is not to address the question of His own sinlessness or oneness with God the Father, but to guide the man to acknowledge that only

God is altogether good and that we cannot earn our own salvation.
