In Rom. 12:3, what is the meaning of "Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought" and "think of yourself with sober judgment?"

Response: The word translated into "think of yourself more highly than you ought" literally means "think way over the top," and "think of yourself with sober judgment" literally means "think within the boundary." No one can do all things. We have to admit our limitations and cooperate with others. That is why Paul continues to say in vv. 4-8 that we should use our gifts to function as one body.
