• **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...  
*In 1 Cor. 3:16-17, what is meant by destroying the temple of God?*

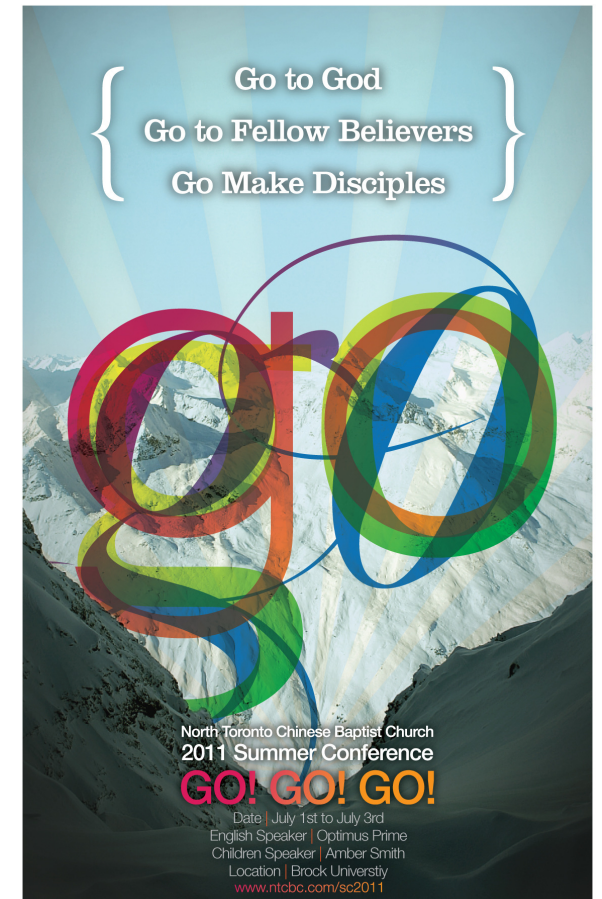
