• **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...  
*Did God really forsake Jesus on the cross? (Mark 15:34)*

**Response:** Jesus was simply quoting Psalm 22:1a, and He is likely referencing the entire psalm since it was common to only quote a smaller section of a larger portion of known scripture that hearers would readily recall. The answer to Jesus' declaration is found two verses down in Ps. 22:3a... "Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One." God's holiness demanded a payment for sin, and Jesus was recognizing that on the Cross as He paid the penalty for our sins there. For both the psalmist and Jesus, while it may seem that God had forsaken them, they knew that He was not far off and redemption was sure to follow. Both the psalmist and Jesus knew this truth and had faith in God's character.

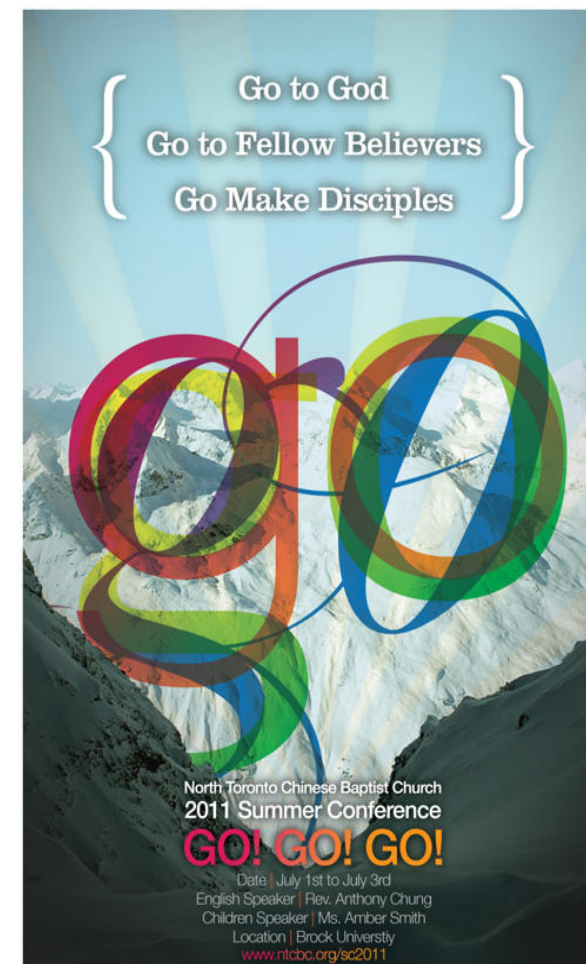
