**● ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...

*1 Samuel 17:50-51 credits David as the one who killed Goliath. Yet in 2 Samuel 21:19, it recorded that Elhanan killed Goliath. Who really killed Goliath the giant?*

**Response:** During the time of David, there were actually 2 different persons with the same name Elhanan. In 2 Samuel 23:24, it recorded Elhanan son of Dodo from Bethlehem as one of the mighty warriors of David. Then

1 Chronicle 20:5 says the other Elhanan son of Jair killed Lahmi the giant who was a brother of Goliath. Since Lahmi was an unfamiliar name, and 'Lahmi' looks similar to 'Bethlehemite' in the original Hebrew text, it is likely that a copyist of the text in 2 Samuel 21:19 relates Elhanan from Bethlehem to Lahmi and the sentence became 'Elhanan the Bethlehemite killed Goliath'. Thus, David was the one who killed Goliath the giant (as recorded in 1 Samuel 17:50-51) and Elhanan killed the brother of Goliath (as recorded in 1 Chron.20:5).

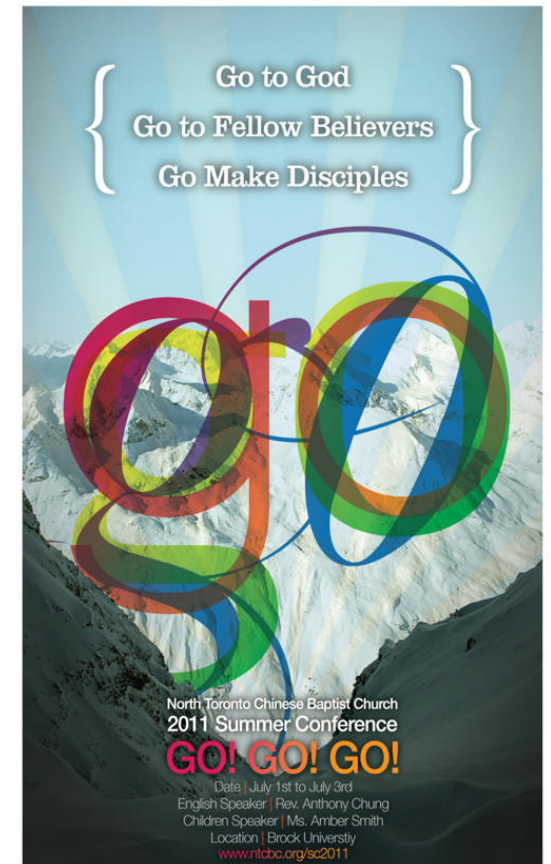
