Response: Some people interpret this passage from a sacramental understanding. Jesus is talking about the Lord's Supper (Communion). But questions will arise if we believe that by taking the bread and grape juice during the Lord's Supper, we have eternal life. Obviously, this is not true. The truth is that the flesh and

blood are striking metaphors for identifying with Christ in His atoning death for our sin.

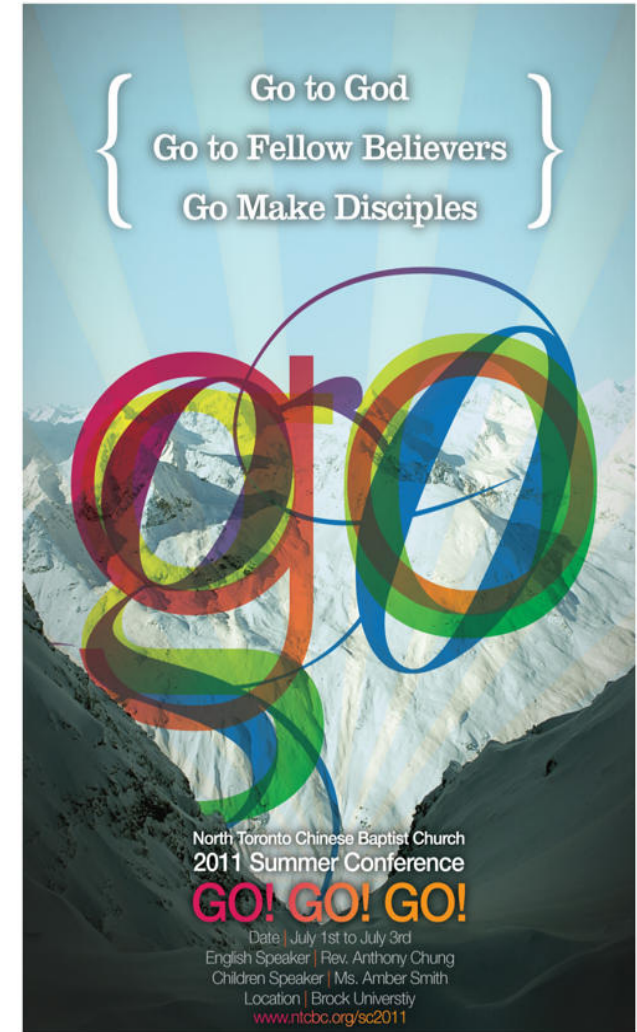
