#### • ASK THE PASTORS! This week's question...

*Matthew 1:16 mentions that Joseph's father is Jacob, while in Luke 3:23 Joseph is the son of Heli. Why is it that Jesus has two different genealogies?*

**Response:** Matthew traces the lineage of Jesus through David's son Solomon, which may be legal descent, whereas Luke traces through David's other son Nathan along the biological line. In these genealogies, we must

not expect accuracy by our modern standards. Omissions, variant spellings, and even variant names may be expected for theological purpose, but they are considered as factual data.
