• ASK THE PASTORS! This week's question...

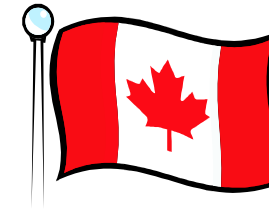
In Jonah 3:10, when the people of Nineveh repented of their wicked way, God relented concerning the calamity which He had declared He would bring upon them. Why does God relent?

Response: Some Bible translators highlight the difference between "repent" and "relent." The concept is clearly illustrated in Jer. 18:7-10. According to the original readings, the verb "repent" describes the action of sinners who are regret for and decide resolutely to turn away from their sins. Whereas the verb "relent" (sometimes translated "reconsider" as in Jer. 18:10 in

NIV) describes the according turnaround reaction in attitude of God who is always willing to forgive repentant sinners. Thus, because the people of Nineveh repented, God relented in imposing the calamity against them.
