"descended to the lower, earthly regions" = This refers to Christ's Incarnation, when He came down from heaven as a man into the earth. The "lower, earthly regions" is in contrast to the highest heavens to which Christ afterward ascended (cf. Ps. 139:8; 15; Is. 44:23). The phrase here does not point to a specific place, but to the great depth, as it were, of the Incarnation, including Christ's descent, between His crucifixion and resurrection beyond the earth, the grave, and death, into the very pit of the demons, "the spirits in prison" (cf. Col. 2:14,15; 1 Pet. 3:18,19)
