ASK THE PASTORS! This week's question...

How long did it take for Noah to build the ark before the flood came?

Response:

The amount of time for Noah to build the ark was not recorded in the Bible. Based on Genesis 6:3 concerning the life of human beings at that time "...

his days will be a hundred and twenty years" and 1 Peter 3:20 that "God waited patiently in the days of Noah while the ark was being built" together with 2 Peter 2:5 "Noah, a preacher of righteousness", some Bible scholars suggested that God allowed Noah to build the ark in 120 years while preaching to that whole generation so people could repent of their sins. The important point is not the exact number of years Noah took to build the ark but his example of faithfulness for us in sharing the Good News with our generation that people may be saved.
