• **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...

Why does the Bible commend the Magi for following the star (Matthew 2), when it condemns astrology (Deuteronomy 18:10)?

Response: Astrology is a belief that the study of the stars can enable one to foretell events. The star in Matthew 2 was to proclaim that the baby Jesus had already been born. Jesus also refers to what will happen to the stars during His second coming (Matthew 24:29–30). The stars are God's creation. They declare God's glory (Psalm 19:1-6). The security of a person's future is in the hand of the sovereign God. It can be ensured by obeying Him, not by practicing astrology.

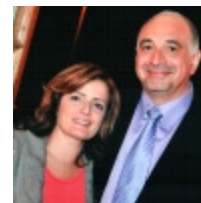
PRAISE & PRAYER:

Mission Seminar - Saturday, August 6, 2011 at 7:30 pm **"Equipping the Saints - Arab World Missions"**



To many of us, the Arab countries in the Middle East are a mythical world. While news networks like CNN do a great job in telling us the sensational political news that are happening there, they will not tell us how God is at work in this most challenged Arab Muslim ministry.

On August 6 evening, the Haddads, our supported missionaries, will paint a picture of the religious landscape of the Arab world and the state of the Church there. They will inform us about the various Baptist ministries in Lebanon and how they are making an impact in the region. They will also share about their own personal calling to ministry, and will give us some idea on how NTCBC can partner with what God is doing in that part of the world.

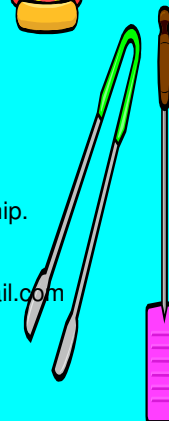
