**In Matthew 15:26, why does our Lord Jesus show contempt to the Canaanite woman by comparing her to a dog?**

**Response:** Jesus does not actually despise her as a dog, such as the Jews did to the Gentiles in general in those days. From the immediate context that follows, Jesus heals her daughter, and praises her faith. This fact shows that our Lord is testing the woman rather than treating her with contempt.

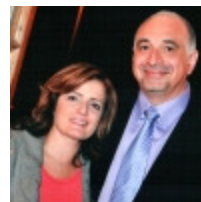
### A new kind of English Cong. Prayer Meeting

To many of us, the Arab countries in the Middle East are a mythical world. While news networks like CNN do a great job in telling us the sensational political news that are happening there, they will not tell us how God is at work in this most challenged Arab Muslim ministry.

On August 6 evening, the Haddads, our supported missionaries, will paint a picture of the religious landscape of the Arab world and the state of the Church there. They will inform us about the various Baptist ministries in Lebanon and how they are making an impact in the region. They will also share about their own personal calling to ministry, and will give us some idea on how NTCBC can partner with what God is doing in that part of the world.
