• **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...

Proverbs 26:4-5 seems to contradict each other. Why?

Proverbs 26

4 Do not answer a fool according to his folly, or you will be like him yourself.

5 Answer a fool according to his folly, or he will be wise in his own eyes.

Response: Verse 4 instructs us not to stoop to the level of fools (using their tactics and style of communication), while verse 5 indicates that sometimes folly must be plainly exposed and denounced. . More foundational to the reactions to fools is our wisdom to discern which way to react. Wisdom comes from God. (Prov. 2:6)

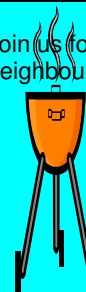

Time for our Annual BBQ with our Brothers & Sisters In Christ at Yorkview Heights Baptist Church next door

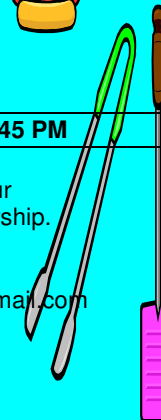

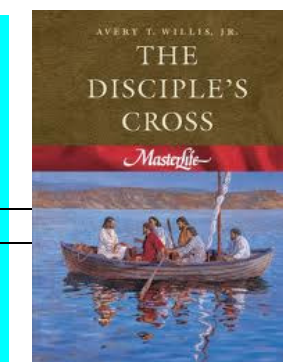
