• **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...

Deut. 1:42 mentions that God "is not among" the Israelites. Does this contradict with the fact that God is omnipresent?

Response: For sure, God is omnipresent. But God also has His own plan. If we look at the immediate context, we will realize that the Israelites disobeyed God's command (1:26), did not trust God (1:32), and rebelled

against Him by attacking the Amorites (1:43). All these prove to us that the Israelites despised God. Thus, God was "not among" them, meaning that He removed His providential hand from them, resulting in them losing the battle. This passage teaches us that we have to discern and walk according to God's will.
