● **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...

The Last Supper recorded in Luke 22:14-22 includes cup, bread and cup, which is different from the accounts of other Gospels. Why?

Response: The Last Supper Jesus had with His disciples is actually the Jewish Passover meal. At that time, the meal includes: 1. Drinking of cup; 2. Exposition and meaning on Deut. 26:5-11 or other Exodus passages; 3. Drinking of cup; 4. Sing Psalms 113-114; 5. Eat bread; 6. Drinking of cup; 7. Drinking of cup; 8. Sing Psalms 115-118. Thus, all Gospel records are a "condensed" edition of the event. The focus is on the meaning rather than the procedure of the event. The body of the Pascal Lamb is broken for us, His blood shed for us, as a ransom paid for us.

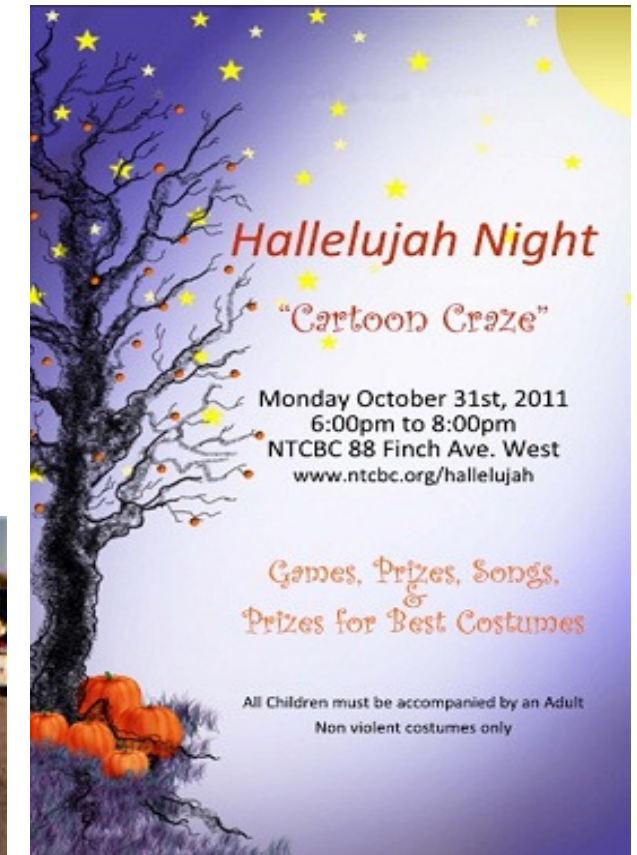
