● **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...

In 1 Peter 1:9, Peter seems to be speaking of salvation as a goal in the future, not as something already possessed. Is salvation a past fact, a present process, or a future event?

Response: It is true that the New Testament sometimes speaks of salvation in the past tense (Acts 15:11; Rom. 8:24; Tim. 3:5) and also as a present process (1 Pet. 3:20). However, in the New Testament, salvation is normally viewed as a future event, that is, to be saved from God's final judgment (Rom. 5:9-10; 1 Cor. 3:15; Heb. 1:14). It is clear that salvation is not only a one-time event when one makes up their mind to accept Jesus as their saviour, but a decision of conversion that leads one to commit to life as a disciple of Jesus, until one experiences the reality of salvation from God's wrath on Judgment Day.
