Paul says that the words "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35) are the words the Lord Jesus Himself said. Why can't we find these words in any of the four Gospels?

Response: Paul is apparently here quoting a saying of Jesus that was known to the church at that time. The words are brought down to us in oral tradition or in a written source that is not preserved. There are a variety of similar statements made by other people in Jewish, Greek and early Christian literature.

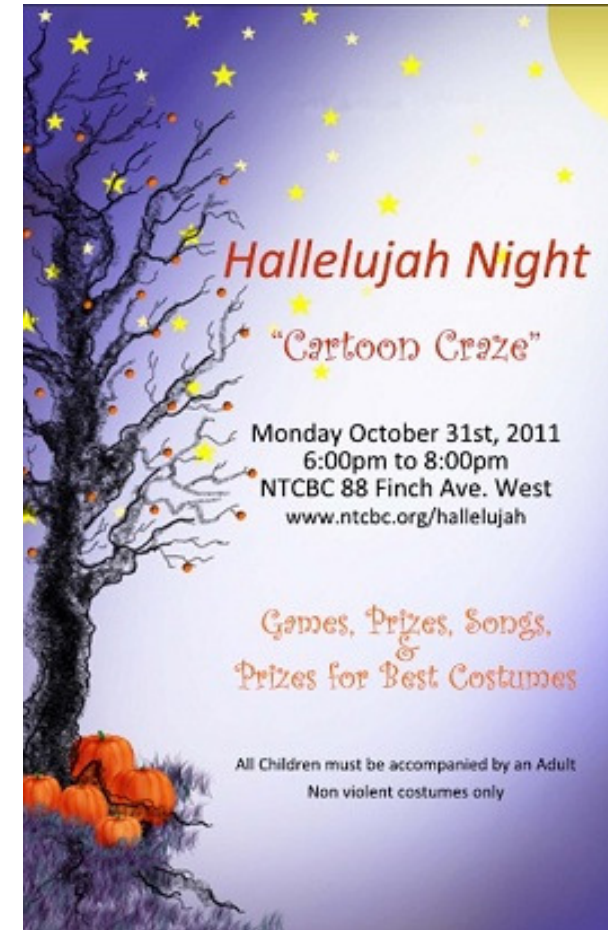
