• **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question...

In 1 John 5:6-8, it says that Jesus Christ is the one who came by "water and blood" and "there are three that testify: the Spirit, the water and the blood". Is John talking about the 'blood and water' which came out of Jesus' body on the cross as recorded in John 19:34?

Response: In this passage, 'water' stands for the baptism of Jesus and 'blood' for his death on the cross.

The apostle John wrote this epistle so we can believe that "Jesus is the Son of God," the Incarnate Christ – he was a real human being and is also the infinite God. As a man, Jesus was baptized before embarking on a public ministry to proclaim the Gospel heard and seen by thousands of people. At the end Jesus died on the cross marked with real blood. While the Holy Spirit bears ongoing witness to Jesus Christ in believers' hearts, his baptism by water and his death with blood on the cross are two historical events testifying to all of us of Jesus' human identity.
