• ASK THE PASTORS! This week's question...

Lamentations 3:38-39 indicates that the calamities were God's punishment for sin. How should Christians apply this message?

Response: The Prophet Jeremiah delivered God's message to the Israelites in his time that the calamities brought by the enemies were the result of their great sin. The cause of calamities in this message is not the same with what happened to Job, which started with the challenge of Satan regarding Job's fear of God.

However, whatever the cause, the solution comes from turning to God and seeking God's salvation, because God is gracious and merciful, and He does not willingly bring affliction or grief to human beings (Lam. 3:33).
