• ASK THE PASTORS! This week's question...

How do I know if I am abiding in Christ's love? (John 15:10)

Response: Jesus said if you keep His commandments, you will abide in His love (Jn 15:10). He was not being legalistic (saved by works), but rather, He was pointing out that our connectedness to Him is what produces obedience. In the same way that a branch can only produce fruit if it is connected to the vine, so we can only keep His commandments if we remain in Him and allow

the Holy Spirit to flow forth from us, producing good fruit (Jn 15:5, Jn 7:38). We will know if we are abiding in Christ if we are producing fruit, which is an increased love for God (Deut 6:5) and for others (Jn 13:34-35).
