● **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question... **Christ is the propitiation for our sins. (1 John 2:2) What is the meaning of "propitiation"?**
Response: The word "propitiation" (NASB95, NKJV, ESV, ASV) is the Greek word *hilasmos*. Some translate into "atoning sacrifice" (NRSV, NIV), or "the means by which our sins are forgiven" (GNB). It appears also in 4:10. The basic meaning of the word is satisfaction. Christ redeemed us from our sin, satisfying God's righteousness, and relieving God's wrath against sinful persons.

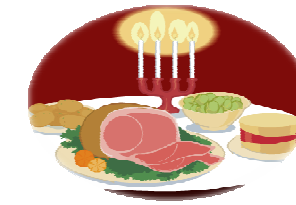
