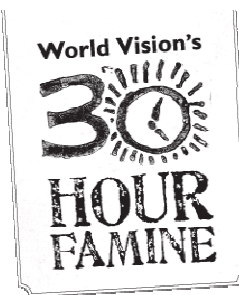

● **ASK THE PASTORS!** This week's question... **What does "making it clear" in Nehemiah 8:8 (NIV) mean?**
Response: In Neh. 8:8, the Israelites were celebrating the Feast of Trumpets. They were thankful because God graciously assisted them in rebuilding the wall. They were willing to listen to God's Word for 6 hours. *Pārāš*, the root of *mēpārāš* (making it clear), means "to separate." When Ezra read from the Book of the Law of God, he "broke out" the standard Pentateuchal sections and explained the meaning. Therefore, it indicates that the exposition of the Bible is very important for understanding the meaning.
