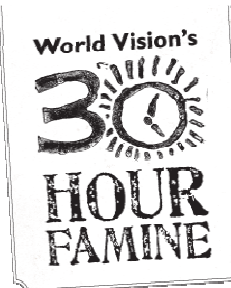


**Lansing Seniors Home Caroling - Sat. Dec 17 @ 2pm**
