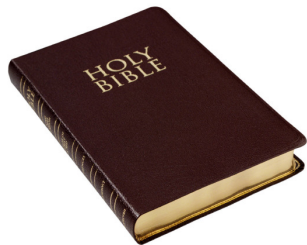

Ask the Pastors

In Joshua 5, before the Israelites attacked Jericho, the Bible states in verses 13-14 that Joshua "... looked up and saw a man standing in front of him with a drawn sword in his hand. Joshua went up to him and asked, "Are you for us or for our enemies?" "Neither," he replied, "but as commander of the army of the LORD I have now come." Who was this commander of the army of the LORD, and why did he say that he was neither for the Israelites or for their enemies?

Response: Scholars believe this commander was either an angel representing God or a pre-incarnate appearance of Christ (Christophany). The Commander, sword drawn, showed a posture indicating He was set to give Israel victory over the Canaanites, but He also emphasized that He is sovereign and the true leader. The question is not whether God is on our side against our enemies, but whether we are on his side. The battle belongs to the Lord.
