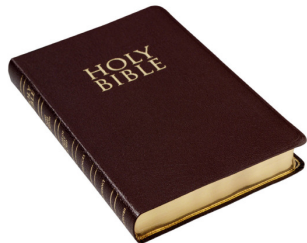

### Ask the Pastors

Why does God set up the Cities of Refuge in Joshua 20? **Response:** According to the Old Testament law code, one of the standards of murder punishment is life for life (Exodus 21:23-25). The establishment of the Cities of Refuge is not for harboring a murderer, but rather granting an opportunity for someone who commits unintentional murder (manslaughter) to start a new life. For the sake of fairness, someone accused of killing another has to undergo a public hearing process. If the homicide is proved to be unintentional, a death sentence is not deserved. See Deut. 19:4-10. Although the victims definitely have reasons to grieve, they can also actually stop committing revenge. Theologically speaking, this highlights the dual attributes of God's mercy and justice. This also serves as a typological foreshadow of Jesus Christ's forgiveness of sins on the cross.
