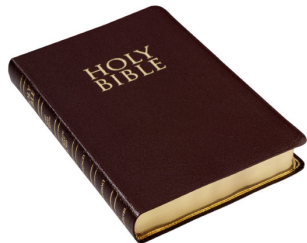

Prayer Ministry

- Prayer Workshop starts at 7:15pm on Wednesdays in the Mezzanine

- 20/20 Vision of Prayer: If you have decided to commit to our 20/20 Vision of Prayer (20 min. of personal prayer daily and 20 min. of corporate prayer weekly), please remember to fill out the card and hand it in to either the Welcome Table downstairs during Snack Time, or to one of your Community (Small) Group Leaders. Additional Prayer Cards are at the Welcome Table and can also be returned there as well.
- Fasting Prayer this Wednesday, May 2. Some churches or believers often practice fasting prayer. On this topic, different traditions have different practices. One of the reasons the church practice fasting prayer is to focus on praying for some very important things. The Bible mentions Antioch type fasting (Acts 13:1-3) where they pray for the missional direction, Susa type fasting (Esth. 4:3, 16) where they pray for the fate of the nation, Ahava type fasting (Ezra 8:21-23) where they pray for a safe journey, and the Hermon type fasting (Matt. 17:21) where they should pray for spiritual warfare. Of course, there are other Biblical teachings about fasting that are also very important.

This year, we introduce two fasting prayers, May 2 and Oct. 3, on top of our regular Wednesday prayer meetings. This Wednesday, in addition to the Repentance and Revival prayer, our fasting prayer will focus on some important issues related to the church and the community. We invite all those who would like to take this challenge to fast on Wednesday night and joint our 8 o'clock prayer meeting at church. We also urge you to make modest adjustment in accordance with their own physical situation by taking water and white bread if necessary. Of course, even if you do not fast, you are still welcome to join us in prayer. And of course, it is our fervent hope that you too can join the 7:15pm prayer workshop.

Ask the Pastors

What is the meaning of "handing this man over to Satan, so that the sinful nature may be destroyed and his spirit saved on the day of the Lord" in 1 Corinthians 5:5?

Response: Some scholars hold that "handing over to Satan" is an act of excommunication, and God permits Satan to attack and gradually weaken that sinner's physical body. During this process, the sinner might reflect on his/her condition and repent. "The day of the Lord" seems to refer to the Judgment day. Believers have received salvation once they believe. But their salvation, including the resurrection of their bodies, is not fully realized until the day of the Lord. Therefore, the expelled sinner who repents would be counted in the list of the saved.
