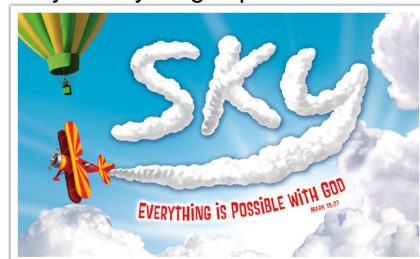
## PRAYER MINISTRY

## ASK THE PASTORS

Why does God say, "I regret that I have made Saul king." (1 Sam. 15 11)?

Response: The concept of God's "regret" describes the turnaround reaction in attitude of God who is

willing to forgive if the sinner repents. (See Ask the Pastors on June 19, 2011's bulletin.)

God knows all things. He certainly foreknew that Saul's rule would be a total failure in his last days. However, God still gives him opportunities to serve Him by saving the Israelites from their enemies. The fact is that Saul actually suppressed the Ammonites, the Amalekites and the Philistines so that the Israelites regained courage. Nevertheless, God's foreknowledge of Saul's disobedience and rebellion makes Him totally reject Saul and pass the dynasty to David. Anyhow, Saul does not respect God's decree that Samuel gave to him, and is bigoted in his own way instead of listening to God's command. Therefore, God said to Samuel, "I regret that I have made Saul king."
