**ASK THE PASTORS**

**Q:** Proverbs 6:17-19 lists seven things that the LORD hates. But why does verse 16 first say there are six things, then changes to seven?

**A:** Similar to Proverbs 30:18-19 and 30:29-31, this is another example of number parallelism in Hebrew poetry. Six or seven is not an exact number that refers to how many things the LORD actually hates. Some scholars suggest that by contrasting, the second number is emphasized, and the intention of this structure is to highlight the final item of the list. That is, the LORD hates most those who sow discord in a family. We need to be careful about our thought, attitude, behavior and tongue, so that we would not cause discord in God's family and become one hated by the LORD.

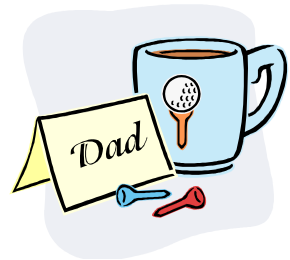
