ASK THE PASTORS

Q: In Philippians 2:1, what did Paul mean when he wrote "fellowship of the Spirit"?

Response: The word 'fellowship' is also translated as 'partnership' (Phil. 1:5), 'participation' (1 Cor. 10:16) and 'to share' (Heb. 13:16) in NIV. The word 'Spirit' is in the genitive case, signifying possession. Literally, the phrase means 'fellowship belonging to the Holy Spirit.' It expresses a close relationship between believers with God or with other believers in that they can participate in, share with or bear for one another. In this passage Paul was appealing to the Christians in Philippi that since they shared in the same Holy Spirit they were also moved by the same Spirit. Hence they should be in the same mind and purpose and love one another in unity.
