An offer to visit any of your non-Christian or seeker friends



Our English Congregation will be starting the Everyday Evangelism (EV2) evangelism trainers training this coming Tuesday (July 3) at 7:00 pm. We'll be meeting every Tuesday night for about 6 months. Part of the meeting every week is called "On the Job Training" (OJT) when we will go outside to share the good news with people at parks, malls, subways, coffee shops, etc. We also want to visit homes or meet with the non-Christian/seeker friends of people in the church.

Are there any people that you would like our team to visit? We could either go to their homes, or meet them informally in a coffee shop or restaurant. We would prefer the meeting to be on a Tuesday evening, but if that is not convenient, just let us know and we can schedule on another night.

There are many reasons why you may want us to visit one of your non-Christian friends, co-workers, schoolmates or relatives, including...they are spiritual seekers; they have been going to church for a long time but have never heard the gospel shared clearly, they are curious about the Christian faith or about our church, they would simple like someone to pray for them because of a large issue in their life (relationship problems, work problems, school problems), they are new to our city and church, they had some questions about the Christian faith, they are elderly and lonely, they are having physical problems, etc. Don't worry, we won't "shove the gospel down their throats." For example, we're perfectly okay with simply sitting and listening and then praying for them at the end without saying a word.

ASK THE PASTORS

Q: Why was the man of God punished despite the fact that he was deceived into sin (1 Kings 13:11-34)?

A: In 1 Kings 13:9, the man of God revealed that he had received a direct revelation from the Lord commanding him not "to eat bread nor drink water nor return by the way that you came." However, he broke all three of these commands when a lying prophet came and deceived him with a false message from God (1 Kings 13:18). The deceiving prophet then issues God's judgment on the man of God in verses 21-22 and there is no record of complaint or rebuttal by the man of God. This passage is found within the context of Jeroboam's reign, who led the nation of Israel into sin (1 Kings 14:16). This story demonstrates that God is displeased at the sins of his own people and that no man shall be protected in disobedience, by his office or any services he has done for him; there is nothing that can excuse any act of willful disobedience.
