Our English Congregation will be starting the Everyday Evangelism (EV2) evangelism trainers training this coming Tuesday (July 3) at 7:00 pm. We'll be meeting every Tuesday night for about 6 months. Part of the meeting every week is called "On the Job Training" (OJT) when we will go

outside to share the good news with people at parks, malls, subways, coffee shops, etc. We also want to visit homes or meet with the non-Christian/seeker friends of people in the church.

Are there any people that you would like our team to visit? We could either go to their homes, or meet them informally in a coffee shop or restaurant. We would prefer the meeting to be on a Tuesday evening, but if that is not convenient, just let us know and we can schedule on another night.

There are many reasons why you may want us to visit one of your non-Christian friends, co-workers, schoolmates or relatives, including...they are spiritual seekers; they have been going to church for a long time but have never heard the gospel shared clearly, they are curious about the Christian faith or about our church, they would simply like someone to pray for them because of a large issue in their life (relationship problems, work problems, school problems), they are new to our city and church, they had some questions about the Christian faith, they are elderly and lonely, they are having physical problems, etc. Don't worry, we won't "shove the gospel down their throats." For example, we're perfectly okay with simply sitting and listening and then praying for them at the end without saying a word.

ASK THE PASTORS

Q: In Matthew 25:14-30 (Parable of the Talents) it says those who have will be given more, and those that don't have will have what little they have taken away. How does one get anything if what little we have will be taken away?

A: The parable of the talents illustrates the tragedy of wasted opportunity. The man who goes on a journey represents Christ, and the servants represent professing believers given different

levels of responsibility. Faithfulness is what he demands of them, but the parable suggests that all who are faithful will be fruitful to some degree. The fruitless person is unmasked as a hypocrite and utterly destroyed. The recipients of divine grace inherit immeasurable blessings in addition to eternal life and the favour of God. But those who despise the riches of God's goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, burying them in the ground and clinging instead to the paltry and transient goods of this world, will ultimately lose everything they have.
