**An offer to visit any of your non-Christian or seeker friends**



Our English Congregation will be starting the Everyday Evangelism (EV2) evangelism trainers training this coming Tuesday (July 3) at 7:00 pm. We'll be meeting every Tuesday night for about 6 months. Part of the meeting every week is called "On the Job Training" (OJT) when we will go outside to share the good news with people at parks, malls, subways, coffee shops, etc. We also want to visit

homes or meet with the non-Christian/seeker friends of people in the church. Are there any people that you would like our team to visit? We could either go to their homes, or meet them informally in a coffee shop or restaurant. We would prefer the meeting to be on a Tuesday evening, but if that is not convenient, just let us know and we can schedule on another night. There are many reasons why you may want us to visit one of your non-Christian friends, co-workers, schoolmates or relatives, including...they are spiritual seekers; they have been going to church for a long time but have never heard the gospel shared clearly, they are curious about the Christian faith or about our church, they would simply like someone to pray for them because of a large issue in their life (relationship problems, work problems, school problems), they are new to our city and church, they had some questions about the Christian faith, they are elderly and lonely, they are having physical problems, etc. Don't worry, we won't "shove the gospel down their throats." **ASK THE PASTORS**

Q: What is the Day of the LORD in Joel 1:15?  
 A: In the OT, the Day of the LORD refers to a day the LORD will judge the evil of the world, but bring salvation to those who repent. The prophets warned about the coming of this day in various times: Joel and Obadiah (9<sup>th</sup> century probably), Isaiah (8<sup>th</sup> c.), Zephaniah (7<sup>th</sup> c.), and Ezekiel (6<sup>th</sup> c.). In the NT, this day is known as the second coming of Jesus Christ. From the beginning of the warning of the prophets till now, God reinforces this prophecy through His awful deeds of judgment, to induce people to repent and prepare for the return of Christ.

**Our Speaker Next Sunday (July 22): Dr. Gary Nelson (President, Tyndale University College & Seminary)**

Dr. Nelson was the former General Secretary of Canadian Baptist Ministries (CBM) our denomination's Mission agency, and was a pastor in western Canada for many years. A recognized urban missiologist, he has authored and presented numerous papers that focus on theological and missiological ecclesiology. His writings include a



book entitled Future Faith Churches: Reconnecting with the Power of the Gospel for the 21st Century co-authored with Don Posterski, Borderland Churches: A Congregation's Introduction to Missional Living, and his most recent book entitled Going Global: A Congregation's Introduction to Mission beyond our Borders co-authored with Gordon King and Terry Smith.
