**ASK THE PASTORS**

Q: "See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven continually see the face of My Father who is in heaven." (Matt. 18:10) Does this verse tell us anything about guarding angels of believers?

A: According to Jewish tradition, everybody has at least one guarding angel to protect him or her. After Peter was released from prison, he went to Mary's house. Before opening the door, they said, "It is his angel." (Acts 12:15) Hebrews 1:14 also tells us that angels are "all ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation." This shows that believers are protected by guarding angels. Moreover, Ps. 34:7 says, "The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, and rescues them." There are other passages about guarding angels. We believe that this is true. Although we cannot see angels, we are seen by them.
