ASK THE PASTORS

Q: Was there an anti-Semitic attitude when Paul said, "the Jews who killed the Lord Jesus and the prophets" in 1 Thessalonians 2:14-15?

A: In the past, some people had wrongly used these 2 verses as justification for anti-Semitic attitudes and actions against the Jews. We must not forget that Jesus himself plus most of his disciples and followers were Jews. They had all affirmed their commitment to their Jewish identity, belief and custom. The apostle Paul who wrote this letter was himself a Jew. He had a deep yearning for his fellow countrymen to accept Jesus as Lord and Savior. And he saw their rejection as a temporary situation for God has not abandoned the Jews forever but will bring them back into His kingdom. In these verses, Paul was drawing a parallel of the suffering of the gentile Christians in Thessalonica to that of the Jewish Christians in Judea since both were being persecuted by their own fellow countrymen. He was trying to encourage and comfort them and was not promoting any anti-Semitic attitudes.
