ASK THE PASTOR



Q: Why the Lord struck the Israelites with a severe plague when they craved for meat (Numbers 11)?
The plague was the Lord's judgment for the Israelites when they rejected the Lord because of their craving. Before they established the covenant with the Lord at Mount Sinai, the Lord had already sent quail for them to eat but without judgment. After Mount Sinai, they should be a holy people for the Lord, but they still complained and rejected the Lord because of craving for food. The Lord asked them to consecrate themselves for the meat, but they still indulged in craving that they gathered themselves meat more than they needed. The whole incident escalated when the Israelites did not get rid of the craving of "the rabble," but allowed it to spread; even the leaders complained that the hardship was brought by the Lord. This incident warns us to get rid of sin before it spreads among the whole community.

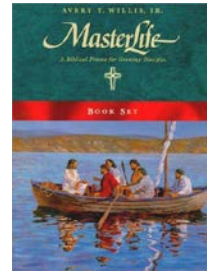
