Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism, Judaism, Mormonism, the list of religions we come across in Toronto goes on and on. We work, study, and interact with people of different faiths or those with no faith at all. It's easy to feel lost when speaking to them about what we believe. They don't understand the differences, and you don't understand where they are coming from. This class will help to address some of the main world views other religions have and how they compare against Christianity. The class will give you a broad understanding of other main religions, while teaching you more about what Christians believe and why its so different than anything else out there. Knowing a bit more about your friend's faith will help you share about your own.

As one of the greatest collections of songs, prayers, and poetry, the Book of Psalms expresses the deepest passions of humanity. In these pages we can hear the psalmist's desperate cry in the midst of despair as well as his ecstatic praise of his Provider and Comforter. We can hear him pouring out his soul in confession but also bubbling over with joy. The Psalms lead us through the valleys and peaks of human experience, but in the end they guide us to the praise of our loving Creator. As we go through the book of Psalms, chapter by chapter and verse by verse, we will both use our heads to analyse it and our hearts to apply it to our lives. Half our time each Sunday will be spent studying the text, and the other half in the ancient practice of *Lectio Divina* (Latin for "divine reading"). Come join us for a weekly oasis in the desert of life; a haven of rest in the chaos and storm of your week!
