Q: Psalms 137: 8-9: Is "dashing the infants against the rocks" a call for revenge? Is it in accord with the teaching of the NT?

A: "Dashing the infants against the rocks" also appears in Jesus' lament over Jerusalem in Luke 19:44. In Psalms 137, it is a figurative speech because there was no rock available in Babylon, contrary to the rocky terrain of most of Palestine. It means that God will destroy Babylon and her progeny for her proud assault against God and his kingdom. Therefore, some scholars suggest that Christians may provoke similar prayers when they clearly realize that the cause of our Lord's great name and kingdom may be at stake. They call upon God to bring judgment against His enemy, not for their own reputation or for personal vengeance. (Cf. 2 Thess. 1:6)
