PRAYER WORKSHOP

Theme for June: Experiencing God's Blessing

19/6	Upon Your Finances	Mat. 6:25-33
26/6	Upon Your Divine Purpose and Calling	Eph. 4:11-16



Q: In Matthew 27:51-53 it states that when Jesus died on the cross...*the curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook, the rocks split*

and the tombs broke open. The bodies of many holy people who had died were raised to life. They came out of the tombs after Jesus' resurrection and went into the holy city and appeared to many people. What happened, and why?

A: The tearing of the curtain signified that the way into God's presence was now open to all through a new and living way (Heb. 10:19-22). The fact that it tore "*from top to bottom*" showed that no man had split the curtain. God did it.

Matthew alone mentions the miracle of the holy people being raised to life. Nothing more is said about these people, which would be unlikely if they remained on earth for long. Evidently, these people were given glorified bodies; they "*appeared to many*," enough to establish the reality of the miracle; and then they no doubt ascended to glory – a kind of foretaste of 1 Thess. 4:16.
