Q: In Proverbs 29:18 it stated that "Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint." What kinds of revelation and restraint is it talking about?

A: The word 'revelation' can also be translated as 'vision' (KJV) and that does not mean having the ability to look to the future and then formulate plans to arrive at that. 'Revelation' is the prophetic vision that comes as the word of God and prescribes the way God desires for us to live. It follows that without the word of God as restraint; people will let loose and live according to their own carnal desires in an unrestrained and obscene manner against God. Hence we must continue to proclaim and teach the word of God so that we can obey and live a truly happy life pleasing to God.
