Q: In Leviticus 11, why does God distinguish between different types of animals that are to be eaten/not eaten?

A: One of the ways in which the Israelites were to distinguish themselves as wholly to the Lord was through their dietary laws. There is no explicit explanation as to why certain animals are unclean. God calls the Israelites to obey because He is a holy, trustworthy God who had delivered them from Egypt. They should therefore be obedient (Lev 11:45). This reasoning is highly significant because God's essentially said, "Obey because I said so." Oftentimes, God's commandments may not make sense to us, but we are called to trust and obey Him because He said so, and He is the same God who died on a cross for our sins and therefore, we can trust that His commands are for our benefit
