Q: Mark 5:1-13 tells how Jesus healed a demon-possessed man by casting out his unclean spirits into about 2,000 swine who subsequently ran violently down a steep place into the sea and drowned. Why did Jesus send the demons into the pigs?

A: According to His sovereign purposes Jesus allowed the demons to enter the pigs and destroy them, but the text offers no explanation. By doing this, Jesus gave the man (and all other witnesses) a graphic, visible, and powerful lesson on the immensity of the evil from which he had been delivered. It is no wonder that when Jesus had earlier asked the man, "What is your name?" he answered, saying, "My name is Legion; for we are many." (vs. 9)
