Q: In Matthew 23:9 it says we are not to call anyone on earth "father," what's wrong with that?

A: In Matthew 23:8-10 Jesus instructs His followers not to call people Rabbi (Teacher) or father. Here Jesus condemns pride and pretense, not titles per se. Paul repeatedly speaks of "teachers" in the church, and even refers to himself as the Corinthians' "father" (1 Cor. 4:15). Obviously, this does not forbid the showing of respect, either (cf. 1 Thess. 5:11, 12; 1 Tim. 5:1). Christ is merely forbidding the use of such names as spiritual titles, or in an ostentatious sense that accords undue spiritual authority to a human being, as if he were the source of truth rather than God.
