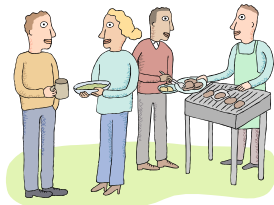
The Quest for Authentic Manhood

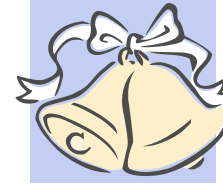
