Q: What is this “veil” when Paul wrote in 2 Corinthians 3:14 that “their minds were made dull, for to this day the same veil remains when the old covenant

is read. It has not been removed, because only in Christ is it taken away”?

A: In this part of the letter, Paul the Apostle is talking about many of his fellow Israelites who are still holding on to the old covenant of the law and fail to respond to the new covenant from God. This is not due to their lack of intellectual understanding of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, but a failure to believe and to obey it from their hearts, just as their ancestors had disbelieved and disobeyed the law in the past. As these people continue to reject Christ who is the only one who can change such stone hard hearts, they will remain in such condition as “the veil has not been removed”. Therefore “the veil” stands for this hardening condition of their own hearts that prevent them from accepting Christ and apprehending the glory of God in this new covenant of salvation for mankind.
