

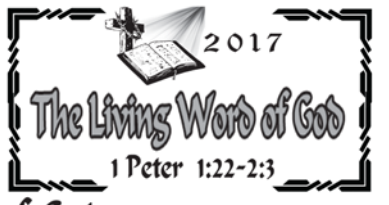

Big Idea: God restores us through the gift of new life in Christ

1. New Life is God's gift

2. New Life restores what was lost

3. New life is offered through Christ

Respond to God

1. Thank God for the New life that he has gifted you. If you are not a believer, reflect over what's stopping you from receiving this gift and pray to receive it.
2. Pray and ask God to reveal areas of your life that you are currently not living through Christ. Repent, and ask God to restore your relationship with Him in this area.
3. Pray for one person in your life that needs the new life that only Christ can offer.
