Sermon Guide

New Sermon Series: Life Under the Son

The Book of Ecclesiastes speaks of the vanity of living a 'life under the sun' where there is no purpose that extends beyond this life. The Bible teaches a completely different reality: God is alive and He has created us for the purpose of living for His glory and His Kingdom

In this sermon series, we will be exploring God's call for our church and what our life looks like as we live under the sovereign rule of God's Son, Jesus Christ. We will be preaching through the different elements of our English Ministry mission statement: to fulfil God's Great Commandment and Commission by nurturing members to be Wordbased, prayer-driven disciple makers and evangelists. We will also be studying the book of Ecclesiastes to identify major obstacles that prevent us from faithfully living out God's purpose for our lives.

This week: People of the Word

The Bible is the Living Word of God; it contains truth accounts of the Living God and is the way by which God speaks to His people today. Christians are called to root our lives in the truths found in the Bible and to seek God's voice through the reading of the Bible. As a church, we strive to nurture members to become people of the Word by preaching and teaching God's Word in community so that we can worship and obey Him, bringing glory to God and reaping joy for ourselves.

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LEAN IN: What is one thing that almost everyone who meets you notices about you?

LOOK DOWN: Read the Scriptures and Answer 1. Read Nehemiah 8:1-8 and contrast Ezra's role with the Levites' role in preaching/teaching.

- 2 .Review Nehemiah 8:1-12 and describe how Ezra and the Levites worked together to deliver God's Word to His people.
- 3. Read Nehemiah 8:6, 12 and describe how the Israelites responded to preaching and teaching.
- 4. Read Nehemiah 8:9-12 and identify the link between obedience and God's glory/our joy.

LOOK OUT: Discuss the following:

- 5. What are the specific roles/responsibilities for pastors & Small Group Leaders when it comes to teaching and preaching?
- 6. What obstacles would prevent the pastors and small group leaders from working together to bring God's Word to His people?
- 7. List some pros/cons of separating the pulpit & small group ministry

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

- 8. Think of a time where your disobedience to God has led others to have a poor perception of Jesus Christ & His Church.
- 9. In the past month, how many sermons and Bible Studies do you remember, have you applied, and have impacted your life? What changes would need to be made in your life (and in our church & small group) in order for that number to increase?
