Sermon Guide

Sermon Title: On a Mission

Jesus is on a mission to save humankind. He always has and He always will be. Jesus crossed the lake to Gadarenes to save a man from demonic possession and from social ostracism, and He crossed over from heaven to earth to save us from the penalty of our sins. Those He saves are called to mirror His saving activity. In the same way that the man received a mission after being saved by Jesus, we have also been given a mission: to tell of God's redemptive purposes so that many can know Him and be saved.

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LEAN IN: Icebreaker

1. How much time would you spend searching for a missing golf ball or a lost mitten? How much time would you spend looking for a missing wedding ring, wallet, or car key? Are your answers the same? If not, why are they different?

LOOK DOWN: Read Mark 5:1-20

- 2. Describe the demon-possessed man. What does this teach you about demonic powers? What does this teach you about Jesus' power?
- 3. Jesus crossed the lake to Gadarenes (v.1) and returned back to the other side of the lake (v.21). What is the mission of Jesus as described by Mark? What would be the possible end result if Jesus did not pursue the demon-possessed man?
- 4. Why did Jesus not allow this man to "be with Him"?

LOOK OUT: Discuss

5. How does this passage influence your thinking about (a) God's love to mankind? (b) evangelism? (c) giving testimony about the work of Jesus does?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

- 6. How have you experienced God's saving work in your life? What are some of the things that Christ has saved you from? What are some things that God has saved you for?
- 7. What has God done in your life that you are excited to share about with others?

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word

8. Think of your circle of friends/family who do not know Jesus yet. Make a commitment to do the following with someone this week: Call, meet up, share your testimony, and share the Gospel.
